

# What Are the Risks of Expired SAM Profiles?

Your business certifications become worthless when your SAM registration expires. Small business set-aside opportunities disappear. Your WOSB, 8a, or HUBZone certifications cannot help you win contracts if your basic SAM registration is inactive. You lose access to the billions of dollars reserved specifically for small businesses each year.

The renewal process becomes more complex after expiration. You may need to resubmit documentation that was previously approved. Banking information must be reverified. Tax records require updated validation. These extra steps add time and complexity to what should have been a straightforward renewal process.

Missing renewal deadlines sends a negative message to government buyers about your business operations. They may question your attention to detail and ability to manage important deadlines. This perception can influence their decisions when evaluating your proposals for future opportunities.
